

Claimant Transfer

This **Right of Transfer** is made on [Add today's date]

If you sign this document you are agreeing that in certain circumstances your claim may be transferred to a new law firm arranged by Arto Private Securities S.a.r.l. This transfer would only be carried out if your law firm cannot properly continue with your case and would transfer to a firm who is able to do so. Any new firm would be fully regulated and able to carry out the work in your interest. This is done to allow your solicitor to borrow monies which are used to allow them to handle your claim. It is important that you understand that this does not impact your claim and no sums could be deducted from any damages you receive. If you are not clear about this or do not wish to allow this you must seek independent legal advice.

Between

- (1) [CLAIMANT DETAILS – Name(s) and full current address] (“Claimant”); and
- (2) Arto Private Securities S.a.r.l incorporated and registered in England and Wales with company number B261407 whose registered office is at 2 Place de Strasbourg, 2562 Luxembourg (“Rights Holder” which definition shall include its assignees and successors).

Whereas

- (A) The Claimant is the claimant(s), or intended claimant(s), in relation to a car finance mis-selling claim (“the Claim”);
- (B) The Claimant has agreed that if their law firm cannot proceed with their claim they will allow the Rights Holder to manage the transfer of their claim to another law firm.

1 Consent to Transfer

The Claimant consents to the transfer of the Claim file to another firm of solicitors by the Rights Holders should Elmwood Law Limited confirm that they are no longer able to handle the Claim.

2 Counterparts

This consent may be executed in any number of counterparts and all such counterparts taken together shall be deemed to constitute one and the same document.

3 Governing Law

This Agreement and Consent shall be construed and governed according to English law.
